Introduction

FC Mill Liners, Inc. ("Company" or "We") respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our Privacy Policy (the "Privacy Policy") set forth below.

The Privacy Policy describes the types of information We may collect from you or that you may provide when you access and/or use www.FCMillLiners.com (the "Website"). The Privacy Policy further describes our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing your information.

The Privacy Policy applies to information We collect:

- On the Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and the Website.
- By and through your use of the Website.

It does not apply to information collected:

- Offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by Company or any third party.

Please read the Privacy Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information. If you do not agree with anything in the Privacy Policy, do not access and/or use this Website. By accessing and/or using this Website, you accept and agree to be bound by and to abide by the Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to the Privacy Policy, you must not access or use the Website.

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information by which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline and/or technical information about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us; and/or
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, and/or other tracking technologies.

Information You Provide to Us

The information We collect on or through our Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use certain content, applications, services, and/or programs on the Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence including email addresses, if you contact us. We may ask you for information when you report a problem concerning our Website.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Website and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through our Website.
- Your search queries on the Website.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, We may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information We collect through automatic data collection technologies is primarily statistical and/or technical data and it may not include personal information, but/or We may maintain it or associate it with personal information We collect in other ways. It helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service.

The technologies We use for this automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.
- Flash Cookies. Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies.

How We Use Your Information

We use information that We collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Website and its contents to you.
- To provide you with information, products, or services.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or any products or services We offer or provide through it.
- In any other way We may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose personal information that We collect or you provide as described in this privacy policy:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties We use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which We disclose it to them.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of the Company's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by the Company about our Website users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our [Terms of Use](#) or Terms of Sale and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If We believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others.
